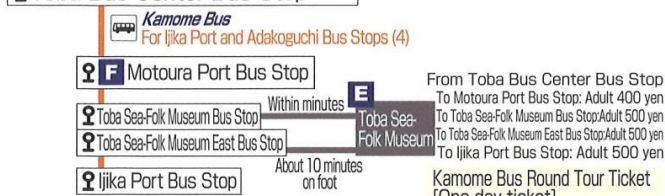


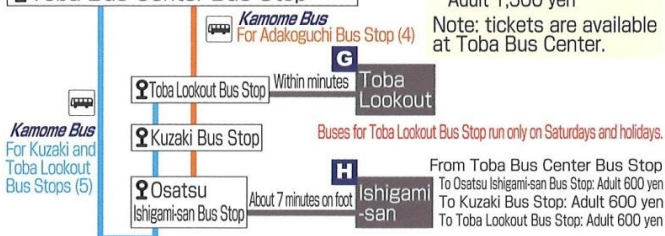
Toba Bus Route Map



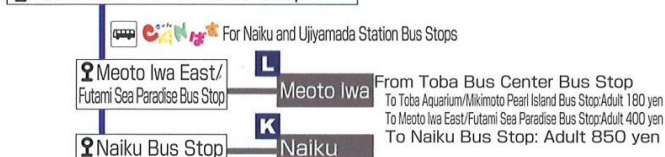
Toba Bus Center Bus Stop

Ishigami-san

There is a small shrine called "Ishigami-san" at the approach to Shinmei Jinja, and it enshrines "Tamayorihime no Mikoto," who is the mother of Emperor Jimmu known as the first emperor of Japan according to legend. Woman divers, namely "ama," have traditionally visited this shrine to ask the enshrined deity to help them realize their wishes: it has been believed that any woman can realize only one of her wishes after she visits this shrine. Today, Ishigami-san is always crowded with visitors from all over Japan.

Uramura Oysters

The sea of Uramura has been famous as an ideal place for oyster cultivation: its nutrient-rich water, which is a mixture of salt water and fresh water, enables exquisite cultivation of oysters. Oysters cultivated in the sea of Uramura are known as "Uramura Oysters" and shipped to large cities such as Tokyo and Osaka.



In winter, you will see a lot of grilled oyster stalls along Pearl Road. All-you-can-eat oysters served at many of those stalls are gaining much popularity. In high season, those stalls are always crowded with visitors and local residents who want to enjoy beautifully-grilled oysters at a reasonable price.

Mikimoto Pearl Island

Mikimoto Pearl Island is the place where Kokichi Mikimoto succeeded in pearl cultivation for the first time in the world. On the island, there are various facilities including Pearl Museum and Kokichi Mikimoto Memorial Hall. Plus, you can even enjoy shopping for pearl products and diving performances by woman divers (ama).

Toba Aquarium

Toba Aquarium keeps the largest number of species (1,200) in Japan. You can see a lot of popular animals, such as dugongs (known as the model of mermaids), sea otters, Commerson's dolphins, capybaras and Steller's sea lions, and enjoy daily performance shows by sea lions and walrus.



Access: [On foot] about 10 minutes from Toba Station [By bus] if you come by Kamome Bus or CAN Bus, please get off at Toba Aquarium Bus Stop or Toba Aquarium/Mikimoto Pearl Island Bus Stop. Note: there are two or three buses from Toba Bus Center Bus Stop per hour.

Toba Sea-Folk Museum

Toba Sea-Folk Museum has about 60,000 exhibits related to the sea, such as tools used by woman divers (ama) and wooden ships: 6,879 of them are designated as nationally-important tangible folk-cultural properties. Plus, the 80 wooden ships gathered from all over Japan are a must-see. This museum received an award from the Architectural Institute of Japan for its well-designed building, which has been often selected as one of the 100 best public buildings in Japan.
